There is a numerous module with Vriddhi required for running the functioning mentioned above.

Evidence of Success:

- 1. Admission Process has been executed through Vriddhi Software. Daily admission statusviz. number of students admitted, according to various functions like faculty, class, subject, category etc. can be easily accessed. Daily account of admissions is prepared simultaneously.
- 2. Book transactions, student and staff visits, New Arrivals can be accessed at any time.
- 3. Office workings have been computerized to enable to meet the workload with minimum number of staff available. It also enhanced the speed of working.

Vidyamandir had decided to develop its own software, Campus 360 to fulfill all the digital needs of all the Colleges, Jr. Colleges, High Schools and even Primary Schools housed by it. The team from a specifically developed IT Section of the Management has evolved Campus 360 for Educational Purpose. All the Staff, both teaching and non-teaching, was given rigorous training in this regard. The software is being updated, as and how it is needed, through the suggestions and queries registered by the workforce at different places. In all, Campus 360 has replaced Vriddhi software totally. The Websites of all the Colleges, Schools are also being developed by Campus 360. Websites designing was done from outside firm, BrainMine Web Solutions Pvt. Ltd.
